

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2019  
Burpengary Meadows State School will receive

**\$236,182\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' or higher for English in Prep to Year 6 from 80.6% to 85%
- Increase the percentage of students achieving an "A" or "B" for English in Prep to Year 6 from 33.1% to 40%
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN Upper Two Bands (U2B) for Year 3 Writing from 22% to 35% and for Year 5 Writing from 5% to 15%
- Maintain the percentage of students achieving results in NAPLAN U2B for Year 3 Reading at 54% and increase percentage of students achieving results in Year 5 Reading from 27% to 34%
- Build the capability of staff in teaching Writing (aligned to the expectations of the Australian Curriculum) through targeted professional development opportunities, coaching, mentoring, professional learning communities and instructional leadership

## Our initiatives include

- Building teacher capacity through co-planning and collaboration to ensure alignment and embedding of the Australian Curriculum, maintaining a focus on writing
- Enhancing teacher capabilities in effective writing practices through effective observation, feedback, coaching and mentoring
- Providing teachers release time to collaborate and co-plan with Head of Curriculum focusing on embedding the Australian Curriculum (with a focus on writing).
- Developing teacher capability to provide curriculum aligned monitoring and assessment, explicit student feedback and effective data analysis
- Providing additional Speech Language pathologist time to provide support and speech language programs for students with identified needs
- Providing targeted intervention and additional classroom support to students with identified needs

Providing additional teacher aide support to classrooms focusing on English to support effective writing practices	\$ 92 242
Provisioning for staff release for the staff development initiatives (Watching Others Work, Feedback and Observation, Curriculum Planning and alignment etc)	\$ 46 440
Providing additional speech language pathology	\$ 27 500
Engaging a high quality teacher in effective pedagogical practices to support the teachers in the teaching of Writing	\$ 68 000
