This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students from Prep to Year 6 achieving a 'C' or better in English from 88% to 91%.
- Increase the percentage of students from Prep to Year 6 achieving an 'A' or 'B' from 41% to 44%.
- Continue to build the capability of staff in effective planning and moderation practices through targeted professional development, coaching, mentoring, professional learning communities and instructional leadership.
- Continue to implement pedagogical practices and supports to target the learning needs of children in Prep and Year 1 with a focus on developing oral language skills and age appropriate pedagogical practices.
- Foster the further building and developing of instructional leadership capabilities of school Leadership Team.

Our initiatives include

- Embed effective instructional leadership practices of the school Leadership Team through executive coaching – refining and enhancing coaching, collaboration, facilitative questioning and teacher capability development.
- Enhancing teacher capabilities in effective reading and writing practices through effective observation, feedback, coaching and mentoring.
- Continuing to provide teachers with release time to collaborate and co-plan with the Head of Curriculum focussing on pre-moderation practices to ensure consistent delivery of the Australian Curriculum.
- Focus capability development of teacher in the Moderation process between the M1 and M2 juncture to align with regional "Leading the Learning" strategy.
- Engaging additional teacher aide to support classroom teachers in delivering effective and researched based teaching strategies, focussing in reading.
- Engaging additional Speech Language Pathologist services to provide support and intervention strategies for students who require speech/language development in Prep - Year 1.
- Establish and implement an effective early intervention program to support children in the early years who are at risk of not achieving benchmarks, providing targeted intervention and additional classroom support.
